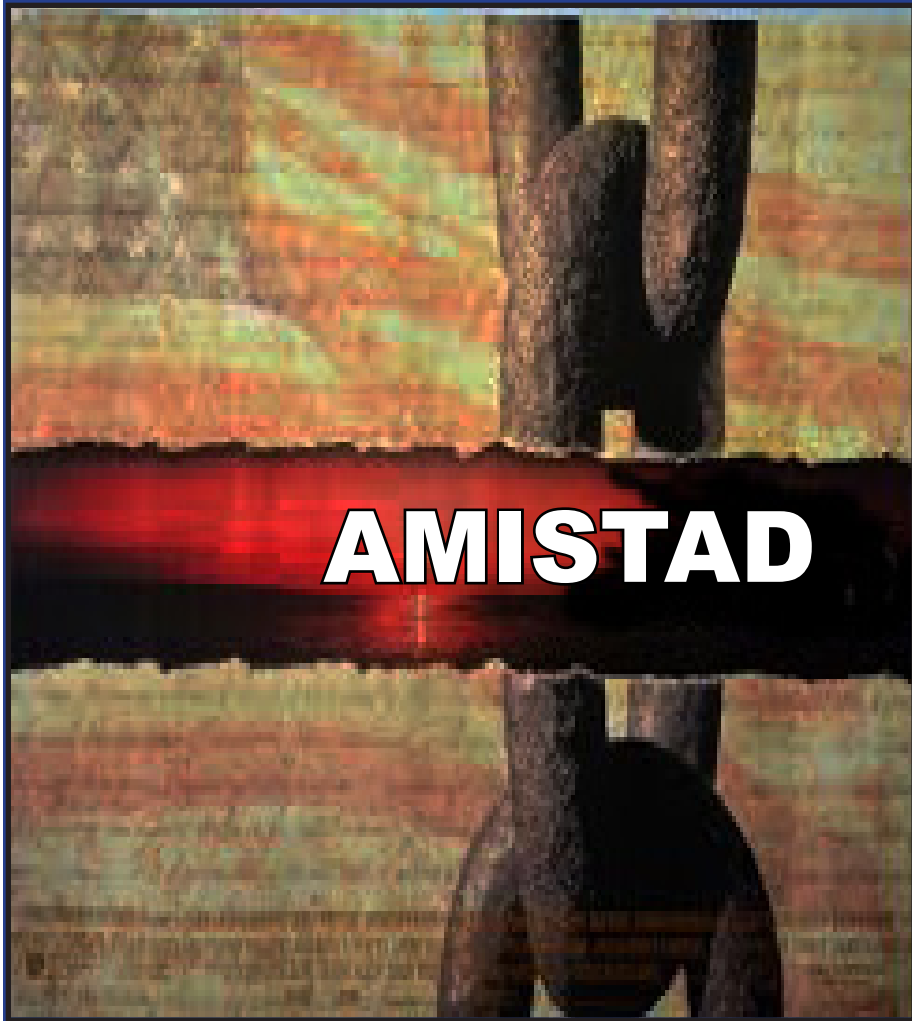

AMISTAD. 1997. 155 minutes. Historical drama. Rated R for violence and nudity. Director: Steven Spielberg. Stars Morgan Freeman, Matthew McConaughey, and Djimon Hounsou.

On a summer night in 1839, Africans in the cargo holds of the Spanish slave ship *La Amistad* break free, arm themselves, take control of the ship, and reclaim their freedom.

Led by Cinque (Djimon Hounsou), they have one goal: to go home to Africa. However, after two months on a ragged course, the ship is captured by an American naval ship. The Africans are charged with murder and piracy.

Former U.S. President John Quincy Adams argues in court on behalf of the Africans. Anthony Hopkins as Adams delivers a brief but masterful portrayal that you will not soon forget, especially as it speaks to our current time of national division.
